

# FleetRiskManager – LearnOnline

---

Once a driver's areas of risk exposure have been identified, typically after undertaking a driver risk assessment such as FleetRiskManager – AssessOnline, it is then important to provide drivers with useful knowledge that enables them to learn how to reduce their risk while driving. Based on scientific research, the LearnOnline module will help drivers understand the influence that attitude and behaviour has on their safety and will help them advance the way they react to the real driving situations they face on the road.

## FleetRiskManager - LearnOnline

The LearnOnline module within FleetRiskManager is a fully interactive online learning environment that develops a driver's knowledge and challenges their attitudes to driver behaviour. It is fully integrated with AssessOnline.

## How does LearnOnline work?

LearnOnline comprises of ten different learning sessions covering all aspects of driving, all accessible from the desktop.

**Anticipation and hazard perception** – explores potential hazards and how drivers can use clues to anticipate danger.

**Attitude and alertness** – Poor driver attitudes and behaviour contribute to 95% of crashes. It considers the 'human factors' and how awareness of these, combined with the correct attitude towards the driving task, can reduce the chances of drivers being involved in a crash.

**Collisions, breakdowns and documentation** – looks at what a driver should do if involved in a collision and what actions they can take to reduce the risk of being involved in a collision in the first place.

**Driving in poor conditions** –explores how poor conditions such as bad weather can affect the way driver's need to act and the decisions they make.

**Environment** –shows how increased awareness of the impact of vehicle use and better techniques can minimise the effects of motoring on the environment.

**Motorway** –considers some potentially dangerous aspects of motorway driving and some of the skills required to be safe on the motorway.

**Overtaking** –demonstrates that safe overtaking requires a great deal of planning and judgement.

**Road signs** – develops a driver's understanding of roads and road signs, informs them of road rules and regulations and how to anticipate the road ahead.

**Safety margins** –emphasises the importance of maintaining space around the driver and the car and guidance as to how much space is needed to be a safe driver.

**Vulnerable road users** –educates drivers about different categories of vulnerable road users who share our roads. It shows drivers what they can do to ensure vulnerable road users are safe.

In addition, LearnOnline includes two learning sessions of fifteen clips and an eye scanning tutorial.

## What are the business benefits?

**Flexible:** LearnOnline sessions can be run separately from AssessOnline or integrated so that the results of an assessment are closely matched to the training.

**'Stop and Save':** learning sessions can be paused at any time enabling the driver to return at any time.
